10. Fees are assessed against Defendant in the amount of \$20 per day of confinement while participating in the work release program; said fees are to be paid to the Jailer as the Defendant is paid by his employer.
11. Failure to abide by the Work Release Order and failure to report back to the Jail at the specified time and date will result in the Defendant being charged with Escape, second degree, Class D felony.
